

RIBA WIN FOR CANCER INSTITUTE

The UCL Cancer Institute: Paul O’Gorman Building has been honoured with an **RIBA London Award**. The RIBA awards are the most prestigious scheme in British architecture and the Institute’s success means it is now eligible for the Stirling shortlist, announced in July.

The Institute opened in September 2007 and houses 350 cancer specialists in a state-of-the-art research environment. Since its opening the Institute has made a major contribution to the study and understanding of oncology worldwide.
